Working together, the teams must use their brains to unravel the clues and find their way to the finish line.

AWARENESS GAMES – All are welcome to compete in The Awareness Games which will take place at The Sight Center that same morning. Touch, smell, taste and feel your way to gold, silver and bronze awards in this family-friendly event.

The celebration will also include music, raffles and games. **Canes, Brains & Automobiles** will end with a lunchtime cookout and presentation of prizes.
